Third-party payment processing websites exist and while they may sound great in helping track your monthly expenses, there are many hidden downfalls to using them. While the website may contain the PRECorp logo, contact information and email link, they are not affiliated with PRECorp.

These third-party services can charge you hidden fees to process your payment and, while you may have made the payment timely to the third party payer, PRECorp may not receive your payment in time. Then you may incur additional late fees from PRECorp, not to mention the risk of your account being disconnected for non-payment.

The PRECorp website provides a link to SmartHub, which is managed by PRECorp and integrates with our billing system. By downloading the SmartHub App on your mobile device or accessing SmartHub through the online portal on our website, you have instant access to your account and any payments received through Smart-Hub are instantly received by PRECorp.

PRECorp also offers all payment type drop offs at the Sundance and Gillette offices during and after business hours; drive-up kiosk at the Gillette office that accepts credit/debit cards and cash; check and payment stubs mailed to the Sundance office; and finally the most convenient payment method of all - auto pay.
