## Attention budget billing members:

Changes are coming to the PRECorp Budget Billing program and when your account will be cleared and adjusted for upcoming year. Look in your mail for a letter that will outline the specific details to the budget billing program. Highlights will also be included in upcoming Power Lines in your monthly statement.

PRECorp offers a budget billing program for residential members to help even out seasonal spikes in power usage over a 12-month period. Annual billing is averaged to enable members to budget a fixed amount for their power bill each month.

You must have 12 months of service history to enroll.

#### How to access the PRECorp units on eBay:

- 1. Go to www.ebay.com
- 2. At top of page to the far right click on "Advanced"
- 3. On the "Advanced Search Page", scroll down the page to "Sellers"
- 4. Check the box titled "Only items show from:"
- 5. In the blank box, type in: vehicles inwyoming
- 6. Click on "Search", or hit "Enter"
- The PRECorp vehicles for auction will appear on the start date and time of the sale.

Once the auction ends, eBay will send out a notification to the winning buyer and PRECorp. At that point, PRECorp will e-mail the buyer with information on how to make contact, payment, and where to pick up the unit.
