
The annual meeting will be held in the High School gym at 11 a.m. The meeting will include remarks from the Board president, Board secretary-trea-

## Notice of Bylaw Amendment

Notice is hereby given that the Powder River Energy Corporation Board of Directors will consider adoption of a bylaw amendment at 9:30 a.m. Tuesday, August 18. The bylaw amendment regarding Article III, Section 1, of the Corporation's bylaws is highlighted in **RED** below:

### Annual Meeting

#### Article III, Section 1:

The annual meeting of the members shall be held in one of the counties of Campbell, Crook, Johnson, Sheridan or Weston, State of Wyoming, or at a location as may be designated in the notice of the meeting, and on the date established by the board of directors and designated in the notice of the meeting. The board of directors will post notice of the date designated for the annual meeting in the principal office of the Corporation not less than 60 days prior to the designated meeting date. The purpose of the meeting shall be the election of directors, passing upon reports for the previous year and transacting other business as may properly come before the meeting. It shall be the responsibility of the board of directors to make adequate plans and preparations for the annual meeting. Failure to hold the annual meeting at the designated time shall not work a forfeiture or dissolution of the Corporation. **However the board may elect, in the event of exigent circumstances, to conduct an election without a meeting pursuant to Wyoming Statute §17-19-708.**
